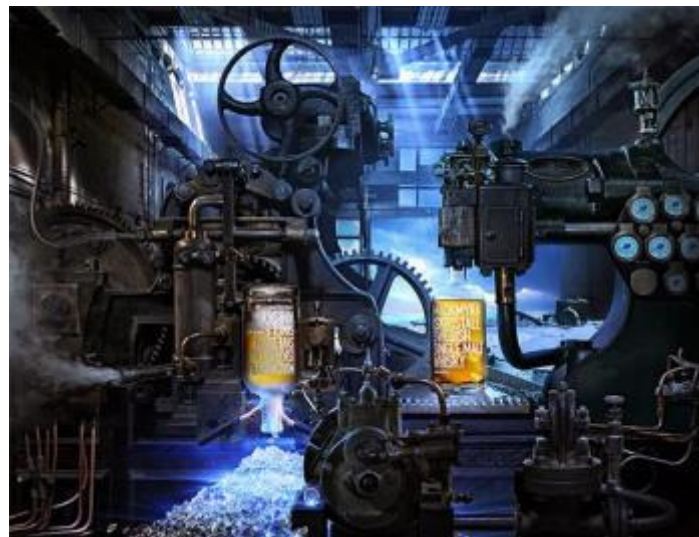

Teeling Distillery

In January last year, whisky bottler and blender the Teeling Whisky Company (TWC) revealed plans to move into distilling, building a €10 million distillery and visitors' centre in Dublin's Newmarket Square, in The Liberties.

The Teeling Whiskey Distillery will be a revival of the original Teeling family-owned distillery that produced Irish whiskey in the area in the 18th century, and marks the first time a new distillery has been built in Dublin in 125 years. In December, Teeling celebrated the installation of its three new copper pot stills, capable of producing 500,000 litres of whiskey per year.

The company has now produced its first whiskey spirit, which will be matured for three years before being bottled. Teeling said the new distillery allows it to have complete control over all aspects of its whiskey production, "from grain to bottle".

The Teeling Distillery is due to open its doors to visitors in May this year.
