Glenmorangie

The Glenmorangie Company has opened his new plant at Livingston which has cost £13million. The whisky's that are being bottled at this plant is Glenmorangie and Ardbeg. This because of the growing demand for these brands. The new plant is a part of a big investment, they already moved there headquarters, sold a bottling plant in Broxburn, ea. With all this renewing they want to invest in the development of the Glenmorangie and Ardbeg brand in the key markets across the world.



LMVH has also announced that Ardbeg is not for sale at the moment and that the rumors and articles on different blogs are not correct.

Scottish Liqueur Centre

The Scottish Liqueur Center has made the announcement, that the visitor centre and cafe of the SLC is now closed. Bruichladdich Distillery

Bruichladdich has installed a new system to get power at the distillery exclusively from recycled whisky waste. This system is based on an old concept that the residual organic material left in the 'pot ale' will be converted into biogas by 12 tons of microbes in two reactors. Then the gas will be fed to a generator to create electricity to power the complete site including the bottling hall, offices and warehouses.



This new system has cost 300000 £, but after 2 years of energy savings it would recover the total cost.

Scotch Whisky Export

According to figures published by the Scotch Whisky Association has the Scotch Whisky export increased by 17%.

Exports to South Korea rose by 69%, while exports to China had an increase of 66 and 34% to the USA. The United States of America are still the biggest consumer of Scotch whiskey in the world.

Single malt Scotch whisky exports rose by 31%

Blended Scotch whisky shipments also up 9%

Macallan Lalique


A Macallan 64 years old Lalique Cire Perdue is being sold at Sotheby's in New York for £288.000. The decanter, crafted by famous French designer Lalique, was created using the "Cire Perdue" or "lost wax" method. Before the auction, the whisky was taken on a 12-city "tour du monde" to build up interest and raise funds for charity.



Ardbeg Alligator

It seems that Ardbeg will launch a new expression. The Ardbeg Alligator for the committee members in March/April and the others in June

From the name I suspect it will be Ardbeg that is either matured or finished in charred American oak casks. Alligator is the name of the deepest way of charring / toasting casks. It refers to the resulting scale-like pattern of burnt wood, similar to a croc's skin. Some influence of Louis Vuitton ;-)



Almost all bourbon makers use this type of charring, but for Scotch distilleries it's less common, but Ardbeg did some experiments with 2 heavily charred new oak casks for Feis Ile 2009: Ardbeg 1998 cask 1189 and Ardbeg 1998 cask 1190.

Burn Stewart Distillers

Burn Stewart Distillers is relaunching his entire malt whisky rang in un-chillfiltered editions. This means that the now existing Bunnahabhain 12y, Tobermory 10y, Ledaig 10y will be bottled at 46,3%. They also launch a new whisky of Deanston by the name Deanston Virgin Oak. The Deanston Virgin Oak is a whisky that is matured in new oak casks from a Kentucky cooperage. The price for this one is only 23,99 euro.





Glenglassaugh

Glenglassaugh has announced to launch a new Manager's Legacy Range. These are single cask bottlings between 1962 and 1986. During these years, the distillery had 4 different managers, and from each period they will choose a cask. Each bottle will be numbered. The 1st release is "The contribution of Jim Cryle", the 2nd release is the "Dod Cameron" bottling and will be available end November. The 3rd and 4th release are planned for early 2011.
